

With Executive Order 202.26 Governor Andrew Cuomo postponed Village Elections until September 15, 2020.

The executive order has also opened up absentee ballots. Anyone may apply for and receive an absentee ballot. This ballot will be counted on election day if the person is registered to vote in the village election.

The application to apply for an absentee ballot is on the next page.

Once the application is complete return it to the Village Clerk.

Once the application is received a ballot will be sent to you.

The last day to request that an absentee ballot be mailed to a voter is Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

The last day for the village clerk to mail absentee ballots to voters is Wednesday, September 9, 2020.

The last day for the village clerk to receive personal applications for an absentee ballot is Monday, September 14, 2020.

The last day to receive mailed absentee ballots is Tuesday, September 15, 2020.

Pursuant to Election Law § 15-118 (2), the last day individuals may register with the county board of elections to be eligible to vote in the village election will be Friday, September 4, 2020.

This application must either be personally delivered to your village clerk's office not later than the day before the election if the absentee ballot is being picked up by you or your designee, or received by the village clerk's office not less than seven days prior to the date of the election if the ballot is to be mailed to you. The ballot itself must be received by the village clerk's office not later than the close of the polls on the date of the election.
