William Morris Park – Survey new fence “arc” and dig test holes

When: Saturday, Oct. 20th

What: Students learn about surveying and engineering for installing fencing (TBD).

- 1) survey for new fencing (Bob Bolton with surveying students)
- 2) dig exploratory holes to identify if boulders will impact post placement.
 - a. Dig one foot deep, 8 inch diameter holes. Number post holes. Record on survey.
 - b. Then use rebar, hammer in with sledge hammer, to test for boulder 1 foot further. Record results by post number.
 - c. Fill holes with sand.

Out of scope: This is not fence installation, it is pre-work to fencing.




