

**PTAB Meeting Minutes June 9, 2021**  
**Meeting Commenced - 6:00 pm**

1. Guest Speaker – K.C. Brousseau
  - Discussion of pump track.
  - Idea is for beginner track in phase 1, more advanced track in phase 2 and beyond.
  - Brousseau noted that many experienced volunteers are ready to build the track once the design and approval have been secured.
  - The first step is to pick a location.
  - Brousseau will get in touch with Steve Langdon and Josh Wilson for further details.
2. Motion to approve May 2021 minutes
  - Motioned: Tyler, second: Ashley, unanimously approved as written with no amendments.
2. Old Business
  - Discussion of where in the Village/Village parks to put new outdoor furniture. Decision to place heavy picnic tables at Riverside Park and black metal table and chairs at Berkley Green. Additional Adirondack chairs will be placed at Riverside Park and adjacent waterfront parks and boat launch as well.
  - Discussion of mural design and fundraising progress. Everyone is encouraged to donate! If the fundraising goal is exceeded, a public art fund will be created.
  - Discussion of community bike ride, coordination is in progress.
  - Report about Ashley's presentation to Rotary about Village parks, Parks Vision Plan, etc. Rotary was receptive about being involved in a fundraising/grant effort for Lake Colby Beach.
    - Discussion of goals, priorities, plans, fundraising, and other considerations for a Lake Colby development project. Decision to move forward with a fence and pavilion project/capital campaign, possibly in partnership with Rotary.
  - Discussion of Bug Crawl installation unveiling.
  - Discussion of claiming parks on Google Maps, Andy and Ezra are working on it.
  - Discussion of volunteer stewardship agreement with the DEC, Steve is working on this and will give them a nudge.
  - Discussion about Baker Mountain/Moody Pond parking/road use issues, and the closed-door meeting that took place in early June with key stakeholders.
  - Discussion of firework clean up during the 4th of July. Decision to observe the fireworks this year to see how everything is set up and what waste can be cleaned up. No formal cleanup effort will take place.

5. New Business

- Decision to focus on committee work and not have PTAB meetings in July and August.
- Next meeting scheduled for September 15, 2021. The rest of the meetings for the year will be figured out at that meeting.
- Community Development updates
  - Village received a DDMF grant from FCEDC to update the wayfinding maps
  - Tree Inventory should start in late July or early August
