1. Wayfinding Signs:

52 total

Type 1: 55X31

Type 2: 32X 40

Type 3: pointing signs on pole

Yellow dots- tested and ready to apply yellow dots on Wayfinding signs.

We will have a sponsor for all available signs, and 2 that are in Jamie's office

Installation of #3 signs- outline and pink flags where signs are to be installed dropped off to Jeff

Installation needs have been defined to Village

Discussion about wayfinding signs and installation to get all PTAB members up to date.

Parking signs have been installed on Wayfinding Signs on those with lots nearby.

Request for Midtown lot parking sign directed to PTAB- Lindy asking how to proceed

Jamie- We can recommend to make signage consistent and show if a lot is public or private

Signs may be placed in the right of way and this will make sure signs are not on private property

Template for consistency

There will be an interactive parks and trails map- hovering above and leading to information- links to BETA, Dewey, ROOST, etc.

**LWRP**- Local Waterfront Revitalization Program

\$75,000- \$100,000 consultant to update the LWRP

Department needs 75%/25% match

Riverwalk Extension

Dorsey Street Parking Master Plan

Check with Jeff ( Village ) on implementation of plan

Start time April 2019 for the contract for "in kind" match

**Downtown Revitalization Grant is submitted-** the Open Houses were a success- 170 participants- looking toward announcements in October

**Smart Growth-** Move forward with design

Lake Colby Beach- design and engineering

Update from Rich- Stakeholders for Rail Trail are getting together next Wednesday June

Jason Smith volunteered and will assume Tom Booth's position - approval of all PTAB members

Winonah Street- needs a complete streets checklist since Jeff is ready to start a street project

**Needs to be done during Summer-** Design work to be done in Winter

Chazen asked for prioritization for the implementation of the Parks Plan. We have listed 3 per park. Now we need to prioritize what needs to happen

Work Session will be needed

Andrea- Look at what can be done across several parks or a park that has priority needs above others

Jamie- Look at what can be done in house and what will need grant money to pursue

Lindy- private/ public partnerships

Need the accepted document

Work Session in August or Fall- August sounds good

Rich- PTAB is best to make the recommendations

To be done with solid recommendations- by December

Think of making Documentation in photos the activities of PTAB members as we work on parts of plan and recommendations

5. Discussion on helmets and safety gear for skatepark

Is there a way to encourage kids to wear safety gear

Is the concern funding, look

Is it accessibility to the safety equipment?

Peggy provided information-NYS has a law for kids under 14 required to have a skate helmet

There is a grant for free skateboards

At events use of helmets is required.

Andrea- Kiwanis partnering to help get equipment to the kids- coordinating with events that happen at the park to encourage getting equipment and handing them out
